


#### Language and communication Skills










# 2. Seminar on Communication Skill and scope of Hindi

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

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








# 4. Listen Up

Launched on August 5, 2022, by the PG Department of English, "Listen Up" is a concise two-minute on-air series crafted to enhance English




language skills. Broadcasting each weekday at 9:13 AM, the program is tailored for efficiency and accessibility.

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








5. Litwit: Talk: Caffeinated Books, A multidisciplinary Thought on space

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
