### PROJECT INTRO


Learning assessments are important to determine what students know and are able to do, identify the areas where they may need additional support or challenge, and measure their progress over time. The assessment helps to identify the strength and weakness in their knowledge and skill, used to measure the progress over time and track student learning, helpful in determining whether the students are meeting expected learning goals and identifying areas where they may need additional support. Learning difficulties can definitely have an impact on an individual's life. It can affect their self esteem and confidence and make it more difficult for them to participate in social activities. However, it is important to remember that everyone is unique and has different strengths and weaknesses, and that there are many ways to support individuals with learning difficulties. With the right accommodations and support, individuals with learning difficulties can succeed and lead fulfilling lives. Students with learning difficulties may have trouble keeping up with their peers in school and may feel frustrated and discouraged. They may experience social challenges, as they may have difficulty in participating in activities or communicating with others. Hence it is important for students with learning difficulties to receive the support and accommodations they need to be successful and reach their full potential. The

**ASER EDUCATION SURVEY 2022**

**PROGRAMME REPORT**

The PG Department of Psychology, in collaboration with Childline Malappuram, conducted the ASER (Annual Status of Education Report) Education Survey 2022 in Malappuram district. The ASER, is an annual, citizen-led household survey that aims to understand whether children in rural India are enrolled in school and whether they are learning. ASER has been conducted every year since 2005 in all rural districts of India. It is the largest citizen-led survey in India. ASER surveys provided representative estimates of the enrolment status of children aged 3-16 and the basic reading and arithmetic levels of children aged 5-16 at the national, state and district level.

Childline Malappuram collaborated with Pratham NGO to facilitate the survey. They organized a three-day workshop to raise awareness among students about the survey's importance and procedures.


**District Level Training Programme:**

29 students from MSc Psychology participated in a three-day training session at PSMO College, Tirurangadi, from October 25-27, 2022. The session prepared them for survey procedures and familiarized them with the survey booklet.

**Field Work:**

From October 28-30, 2022, student teams conducted the survey in 30 villages. Each team, consisting of two students, surveyed 20 randomly selected households per village using the provided survey booklet. The survey focused on assessing the basic reading and arithmetic abilities of children aged 5-16 in rural households. Survey booklets contained tests of various levels based on the children's ages.



  
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The ASER Education Survey 2022 in Malappuram district was a collaborative effort between academic institutions, NGOs, and student volunteers. Findings from the survey will aid in identifying areas for improvement in rural education and implementing targeted interventions.

Engaging as student volunteers in initiatives like ASER surveys provides invaluable experiential learning opportunities, allowing them to develop research, communication, and problem-solving skills in real-world contexts. Moreover, participation as volunteers enables students to contribute directly to societal betterment, fostering a sense of social responsibility and civic engagement that can positively impact their personal growth and community involvement.

മലപ്പുറം കേരള അസോസിയേഷൻ ഓഫ് പ്രൊഫഷണൽ സോഷ്യൽ വർക്കേഴ്സും പ്രൊഫ. എൻ.ജി.ഒ.യും ചേർന്ന് ജില്ലയിലെ വിവിധ കോളേജുകളിലെ വിദ്യാർത്ഥികൾക്കായി നടത്തുന്ന ആനുവൽ സ്റ്റാറ്റസ് ഓഫ് എജ്യൂക്കേഷൻ റിപ്പോർട്ട് പരിശീലനപരിപാടിക്കു തുടക്കമായി. ഗ്രാമീണ മേഖലയിലെ കുട്ടികളുടെ സ്കൂളുകളിലെ പഠനം സംബന്ധിച്ച് രാജ്യമൊട്ടാകെ ഓരോ വർഷവും വിടുകയോടൊപ്പം കയറി ജനപങ്കാളിത്തത്തോടെ നടത്തുന്ന ഒരു സർവ്വേയുടെ ഭാഗമാണ് പരിശീലനം. ജില്ലയിലെ സൈക്കോളജി, എം.എ. ഇംഗ്ലീഷ് വിദ്യാർത്ഥികൾക്കാണ് പരിശീലനം.
