



- Promote the usage of electronic display boards and cloth banners.
- Establish Solid waste management system by segregated collection using colour coded separate bins for wastes.
 - * **Green colour:** wet waste (degradable/organic)
 - * **Blue colour:** dry recyclable waste (plastic, aluminum foil, bottles, cans etc.)
 - * **Yellow colour:** recyclable waste (paper, tissue etc.)
- Wet waste can be degraded through the systems like composting, vermicomposting, bio pedestal.
- Collaborated with Govt. and Non-Govt. agencies for ensuring the effective recycling process of dry non-degradable and E-waste.
- Established incinerators to degrade reject waste.
- Established solar plant and biogas plant for energy conservation.

ENERGY SAVING TIPS

- Activate power management features on your computer and monitor so that it will go into a low power “sleep” mode when you are not working on it.
- Turn off your monitor when you leave your table.
- Activate power management features on your laser printer.
- Whenever possible, shut down rather than logging off.
- Turn off unnecessary lights and use daylight instead.
- Avoid the use of decorative lighting.
- Use LED or compact fluorescent bulbs.
- Keep lights off in classrooms when they are not in use.
- Use the fans only when they are needed.
