

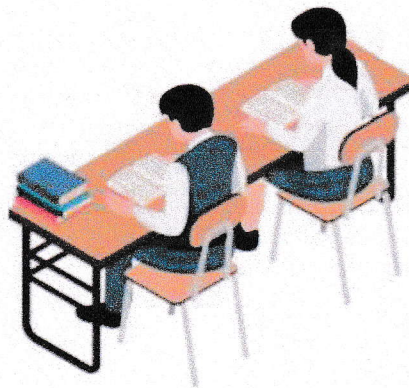

Students identified as needing remedial support may include those who:

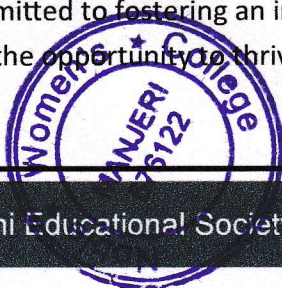
- Demonstrate challenges in core subjects through placement exams or academic evaluations.
