

REPORT ON DEBATE ON ANTI-RAGGING

The Anti-Ragging Cell of Noble Women's College, Manjeri, organized a debate on the topic **"Strict Punishment or Awareness: Which Is More Effective in Preventing Ragging?"** on 20 August 2026 at 10:30 AM in Room No. 4. The programme was organised with the objective of creating awareness among students about the harmful effects of ragging and encouraging them to reflect on effective ways of preventing it.

The debate provided students with a platform to express their opinions, exchange ideas, and develop their communication and critical-thinking skills.
